

TOPAS 0600 DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

GUIDANCE NOTES

This document provides guidance for users to help accurately complete the TOPAS 0600 Declaration of Conformity.

Product Title:

Enter the product name under which the product is sold.

Note:- The term “Product” refers to the item and all component parts and executable instructions which it comprises, for example, PTC1 Family, ST950 ELV, OPTIMA IP OTU.

Product Identifier:

Enter the individual part number and issue state of the product to be Registered, for example A23766-123 Issue 1 or 667/1/12400/000 Issue 6

Where there is more than one product in a family being Registered to the same TOPAS specification, for example a range of detectors or a range of traffic signal controllers, please use Appendix 1 of the declaration to list each of the top level family members and their issue states. In this case enter “See page 3” in this field.

Note: *It is recognised that changes to product sub-elements do not always change the issue state of parent items and may therefore go unnoticed. Where this is the case the Manufacturer should also consider identifying key sub-elements, whose issue state can be tracked to identify where significant product change has taken place.*

Where it is the case that key operating software or firmware may be updated without the issue state of parent parts being affected, the issue state of the software / firmware must always be explicitly noted.

Manufacturer’s Technical File Reference:

Enter the manufacturer’s part number and issue of the Technical File being submitted with this declaration of conformity in support of the TOPAS Registration application.

TOPAS Specification:

Enter the TOPAS specification against which the product is to be registered, for example TOPAS 2500A. If the product is being Registered against more than one specification, list them here.

Specification Appendices:

If the registration is only being requested against specific TOPAS specification appendices list them here. If Registration is against all the appendices in the TOPAS specification enter ‘All’.

Specification Variances:

The Technical File submitted as part of the Registration process must contain a Statement Of Compliance against the TOPAS specification against which the product is to be Registered.

If the product is 100% compliant with the specification enter N/A here. If there are product variances or it is necessary to explain how compliance is achieved this must be defined in the statement of compliance. The part number and issue state of the Statement of Compliance should be listed here and all non-compliances should be recorded at Appendix 2 of the Declaration of Conformity and signed by both the manufacturer and the Technical Assessor.

Manufacturer's Name:

Enter the manufactures name.

Address and Post Code:

Enter the manufacturer's full postal address and post code

Signed in the capacity of:

The Declaration of Conformity should be signed by an individual authorised to declare the conformity on behalf of the applicant organisation and their capacity (for example Engineering Director) stated.

Once completed by the applicant organisation the Statement of Conformity together with the relevant Technical File should be submitted to the TOPAS approved Technical Assessor for completion.
